| Demurrer | |

All requests for judicial notice are GRANTED. Plaintiff concedes that she did not file a timely government claim. Matters of which this Court can take judicial notice establish that no government claim was filed and no request for leave to file a late claim was ever made in connection with this action. Accordingly, the demurrer for failure to file a timely claim and failure to file a request for leave to file a late claim is SUSTAINED.

The plaintiff fails to state facts establishing liability against any of the County defendants. Even if a claim were properly plead, it would be barred pursuant to the immunity granted by Government Code sections 821.6 and 820.2. Accordingly, the demurrer for failure to state a claim is SUSTAINED.

The plaintiff has failed to state any facts to plead around the failure to file a government claim, the failure to request leave to file a late claim, or the application of government immunity under Government Code sections 821.6 and 820.2. This is the third demurrer sustained on these grounds. Absent the specific articulation of facts that would indicate leave to amend would not be futile, leave to amend is DENIED. (Code Civ. Proc. § 430.41, subd. (e)(1).)
